FEDERAL CONSTITUTION (AMENDMENT) ACT 1990

An Act to amend the Federal Constitution.

BE IT ENACTED by the Duli Yang Maha Mulia Seri Paduka Baginda Yang di-Pertuan Agong with the advice and consent of the Dewan Negara and Dewan Rakyat in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Federal Constitution short utle. (Amendment) Act 1990.

2. Article 48 of the Federal Constitution is amended by Amendinserting, immediately after Clause (5), the following ment of Article 48. new Clause (6):

"(6) A person who resigns his membership of the House of Representatives shall, for a period of five years beginning with the date on which his resignation takes effect, be disqualified from being a member of the House of Representatives.".

3. Article 139 of the Federal Constitution is amended, Amendment in Clause (4), by substituting for the words "nor more of Article than thirty other members" the words "other members; but the number of the other members shall not, until the Yang di-Pertuan Agong by order otherwise provides, exceed thirty".

4. Article 141A of the Federal Constitution is Amendment amended, in Clause (2), by substituting for the words of Article "but not more than eight other members" the words "other members; but the number of the other members shall not, until the Yang di-Pertuan Agong by order otherwise provides, exceed eight.".

Amendment of Article 151. 5. Article 151 of the Federal Constitution is amended by substituting for Clause (2) the following:

"(2) An advisory board constituted for the purposes of this Article shall consist of a chairman, who shall be appointed by the Yang di-Pertuan Agong and who shall be or have been, or be qualified to be, a judge of the Supreme Court or a High Court, or shall before Malaysia Day have been a judge of the Supreme Court, and two other members who shall be appointed by the Yang di-Pertuan Agong.".

Amendment of Eighth Schedule. 6. Section 6 of the Eighth Schedule to the Federal Constitution is amended by inserting, immediately after subsection (4), the following new subsection (5):

"(5) A person who resigns his membership of the Legislative Assembly of this State or any other State, shall, for a period of five years beginning with the date on which his resignation takes effect, be disqualified from being a member of the Legislative Assembly of this State.".
