The provisions of any Consequential Provisions Act made under this Constitution and of any Act relating to Citizenship shall not be amended, repealed, re-enacted or replaced unless the Bill incorporating such amendment, repeal, re-enactment or replacement is supported at the final vote thereupon by the votes of not less than two-thirds of the Members of Parliament.".
