Being as Act to amend the Constitution of Sierra Leone, 1978 (Act No. 12 of 1978)

[30th May, 1985.] BE IT ENACTED by the President and Members of Parliament in this present Parliament assembled, as follows-	Date of Commence- ment.
 The Constitution of Sierra Leone, 1978 (Act No. 12 of 1978) is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "seven years" appearing in subsection (4) of section 21 thereof, of the words "seven years and six months". 	Section 21(4) of Constitution amended.
2. The said Constitution is hereby further amended by the insertion immediately after subsection (1) of section 25 thereof of the following new proviso:-	Section 25 (1) of Constitu- tion amended.

"Provided that in relation to the term of the President which commenced with the day of commencement of this Constitution by virtue of subsection (4) of section 21 of this Constitution, the period of seven years referred to in this subsection shall be deemed to read as if it were a reference to a period of seven years and six months".

Passed in Parliament this 15th day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-five.
